# Robeson County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 2

## **How is Robeson County performing?**

**37.4**% of households in Robeson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 26, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **48.5**%. Robeson County is currently ranked 81 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Robeson County?

17.9% of Robeson households responded to the census online versus 41.0% of all NC households.

**19.5%** of Robeson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 7.5% of all NC households.
