

Wayne County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 26

How is Wayne County performing?

47.4% of households in Wayne County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 26, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **48.5%**. Wayne County is currently ranked 37 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wayne County?

35.9% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 41.0% of all NC households.

11.5% of Wayne households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 7.5% of all NC households.
