# Cabarrus County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

# How is Cabarrus County performing?

**30.2%** of households in Cabarrus County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Cabarrus County is currently ranked 36 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Cabarrus County?

**28.7%** of Cabarrus households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

**1.5%** of Cabarrus households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.
