

## Moore County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending Aug 30

### How is Moore County performing?

**60.0%** of households in Moore County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 30, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **60.7%**. Moore County is currently ranked 37 out of 100 counties in NC.

### How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Moore County?

**46.2%** of Moore households responded to the census online versus 47.6% of all NC households.

**13.8%** of Moore households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 13.1% of all NC households.
