How is Wake County performing?

70.6% of households in Wake County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 30, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **60.7%**. Wake County is currently ranked 3 out of 100 counties in NC.

65.0% of Wake households responded to the census online versus 47.6% of all NC households.

5.6% of Wake households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 13.1% of all NC households.
